



Tips to Reduce Your Paper Usage

If you have to print...

- Use smaller margins
- Print on both sides
- Use a smaller font
- Print multiple pages per sheet
- Reusing paper printing on the back
- Recycle the paper you do use!



Eliminate Your Paper Usage!

- Create Online Forms
- Digitalize Information
 - Manuals, procedures, files, directories, etc
 Example: Sharepoint, Shared drive, Wiki Spaces
- EFAX
- Scan, don't fax!
- Email tags: Please don't print, etc.




Benefits

Individual Commitment

- Adjust default margins to 1" or less.

- Add an email tag to my signature asking others to consider their paper usage.
- Scan and email documents instead of using the fax.
